



## Eileen Bunner

October 4, 1948 - April 7, 2020

Tuesday, April 7th, in the early morning, Eileen Louise Bunner passed away due to the complications from ALS disease. She was 71 years old. Eileen was the youngest of three daughters, from the Long family of Sulfur Springs, Ohio. A graduate of Colonel Crawford High School and the Columbus Business University, she started her career as a secretary for the Ohio State University-College of Education. Moving on, she worked as an administrative assistant across Columbus before retiring in 2006 after many years with Nationwide Insurance. Eileen grew up loving horses, exploring the outdoors, and turning her hand at whatever craft she could find. Remarkably industrious, she perfected calligraphy, macramé, stained glass, cake decorating and a host of other hobbies. She also developed a huge love of cats, fostering many and loving her own.
