I was in archery for a while; there was a club at lunch for it. Mr. Pound taught me how to shoot (in which I accidentally learned how to shoot left-handed). I remember in his office he always used the phone camera he had to take pictures for when people hit right in the middle of the target. Whenever the end of the year rolled around; I always made sure to bid my goodbyes and promise I'd see him next year. I'll never forget the moments I had with Mr. Pound; I cherish them. In my Slate Hill yearbook for my 5th grade year; I have his signature printed next to his photo cause I finally remembered to ask him. I'll never lose that yearbook, it's really special to me. Mr. Pound was courageous, and free spirited. On Star Fun day at the end of the year; Mr. Pound would always try his best to get the students what they wanted. Slate Hill would never have been so fun without him there. Mr. Pound will be missed by all of who knew him; myself included. While he may be gone; let his memory live on.
