



Alan Y Carper

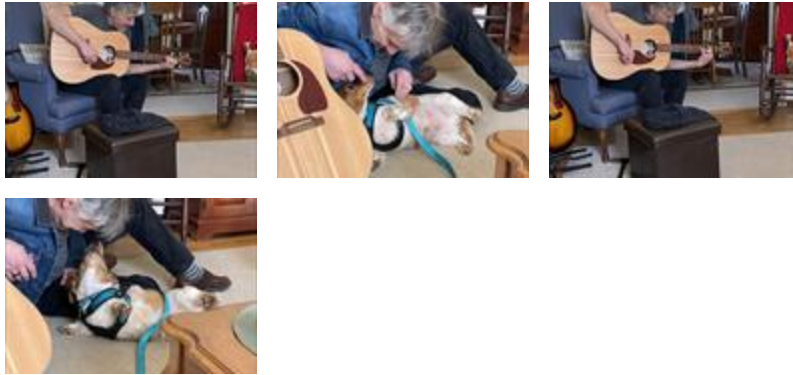
November 15, 1953 - June 10, 2024
