January 28, 1925 - December 14, 2019

Albert P. Dorinsky, age 94, passed away, Saturday, December 14, 2019 at the Forum at Knightsbridge surrounded by family. Al was a longtime active member of Immaculate Conception Catholic Church where he was an usher for 52 years and a member of the Knights of Columbus and St. Vincent DePaul Society. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army Air Corp where he served as crew chief on a B17 bomber and trained as an engineer gunner on a B29 bomber during World War II. Al retired from Rockwell International after 32 years of service. He was preceded in death by his wife of 32 years, Anna Mae; brothers, John and Henry; sisters, Margaret and Sister Rose Anne Dorinsky. Survived by children, Rebecca (Wayne) Kinning, Paul (Nancy), Robert (Hazel), Thomas (Kelly), and James (Christina) Dorinsky; 14 grandchildren; 5 great-grandchildren; sister, Bernadine Matthews; several nieces and nephews.
