A longtime member of the Worthington Presbyterian Church, Al was a former president of the MidOhio League and member of "I Know I Can" in central Ohio. He was a member of the Ohio State University Presidents Club; and a former member of the University, Athletic, Ocean Reef and Worthington Hills Country Club. He was active in Kiwanis, Worthington Jay C's, and the Worthington Cardinal Boosters, as well as the Little League Commissioner. He also served as a board member of Children's Hospital, Otterbein College and Motorists Mutual Insurance Company. Al enjoyed watching all sports: especially boxing. He

sponsored or coached teams for football, basketball, baseball and softball. He loved attending his children and grandchildren's activities: swimming, soccer, basketball, baseball, track, dance and or music. He loved the Cincinnati Red's was a longtime booster of Ohio State football and basketball.
