Allyson Marie Gross, age 24 of Worthington, passed away unexpectedly Tuesday, January 20, 2009. She was born May 8, 1984 to Michael F. Gross and Bobbi May-Gross. She attended St. Michael School, was a graduate of Bishop Watterson High School (2002) and Ohio University (2006) with a degree in Broadcast Journalism. After graduation, Allyson moved to New York City for one year. She returned to Ohio in March 2008 and was employed at Hubert & Huntsman and Cameron's in Linworth.
