Alma S. Ingersoll, 92, passed away 09/04/23 in Powell, Ohio. She was born on March 30, 1931 in Youngstown, Ohio, daughter of the late Andrew and Anna Hartman Schuller.

Alma graduated from South High School in 1949. She worked as a keypunch operator for Automatic Sprinkler and later, Republic Steel. While working at Republic Steel, she met her future husband Robert E. Ingersoll, who preceded her in death. They were married on December 4, 1954 at Honterus Lutheran Church. They raised a loving family and were happily married for 63 years, until Robert's passing in 2018.

She truly appreciated the visits and phone calls from children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews while she lived at Abbington Assisted Living.

Elliott (Jennifer) Ingersoll of Kent; grandchildren, Sarah (Robert) Pence, Melissa Chizmar, Brady Ingersoll and Kaitlyn Ingersoll; great-granddaughter Isabella Pence, and many nieces and nephews. Besides her parents and husband, Alma was preceded in death by her sisters, Helen Strupkus Bendel and Dorothy Schuller, and beloved cousin Christine Pukalski.
