She loved animals and I remember that the very last time she had commented on my new rabbit that had just had his leg amputated. He was out of his cage for the first time after the surgery and she was so excited, and you would think that a rabbit would be limited, but my rabbit, like Angie persevered. The morning after I found out that Angie had passed away my rabbit did his first binkie, which is the jump with a twist and now he's doing them and I said he was doing that for Angie. 😊

I will always remember our visits with her at the house, or a restaurant, the zoo, and our last one was at her last place.

Really God could've taken her anytime. However, I believe He wanted her to be an inspiration for other people just a little bit longer. I often talked about her at my new church. God had a chosen day for her and even though I will miss her horribly, I'm so happy she is free of everything and she is with her Creator.
