Anthony Paul Schultz, 57, of Groveport, Ohio peacefully passed away at home on April 13, 2026. He was born July 6, 1968, to Paul Schultz and Mary Ann (Moskal) Schultz in Weirton, WV. Anthony and Tammara (Tammy) Schultz were married in Columbus, Ohio on May 19, 1996. Anthony was a longtime member of St. Gregory of Nyssa Orthodox Church where he held several Council roles, as well as a member of the Fellowship of Orthodox Christians in America where he held the position of Sports Director for many years.

Anthony graduated from West Liberty University (formerly known as West Liberty State College) in West Virginia, where he was a member of Gamma Sigma Tau and returned to spend Homecoming Weekend with his fraternity brothers each fall.

He took extraordinary pride in caring for his yard and had a passion for sports. A devoted Columbus Blue Jackets fan, Anthony enjoyed attending team events and sharing season tickets with his daughter, Elexis. A proud girl dad, Elexis shared his interest in hockey and baseball while his daughter, Kendall matched his love of football and basketball – though they rarely agreed on a team. His enthusiasm for golf and soccer, however, was mostly enjoyed on his own.

He is survived by his wife, Tammy Schultz, and daughters Kendall Sauner and Elexis Schultz, his siblings Paula (Jimmy) Exler, Patricia Schultz, Deacon John (Sonia) Schultz, his twin brother Michael (Airry) Schultz, and his in-laws Butch and Doris Russell. Anthony also leaves behind his nieces and

nephews: Natasha Exler, Alexandra (Anthony) Granzianis and great-nephew Roman Granzianis, Samantha Exler, Sarah Schultz, John Schultz Jr., and Joshua Schultz, in addition to many cousins and friends.
