COLOSIMO, Antonio “Tony” 69, of Powell, OH, passed away Sunday, November 4, 2018. Tony was born in Kettering, OH, attended Alter High School ('67) and then later a graduate of Ohio State University School of Architecture ('74). He started working as a very young man in construction to pay his way through school and became an award-winning Architect / President / Owner of the 3D/Group, Inc. for the past 38-years.

He was the first architect in Ohio to receive HUD’s Chief Architect Award for his design and construction management of an elderly care facility in a national historic structure – 10 Wilmington Place, where he was able to design and restore the 131-year old Dayton State Hospital into a 26-acre apartment community for senior adults.

Tony loved designing, refurbishing and building bars, restaurants, day care facilities, computer stores, homes and businesses throughout the nation, along with Wendy’s restaurants first drive-thru, along with designing several Micro Center Computer stores across the country.

He is survived by his son Marcus (Amy) Colosimo, and his 2 Grandchildren (Theo and Tori Colosimo), his long-time friend and companion, Laural Flanagan, 2 brothers, Joe (Cathy Lee) Colosimo and Carlo (Karen) Colosimo, along with 4 sisters, Margaret Simon, Catherine “Cathy” (Sherry Wynn) Colosimo, Bernadette Mathes and Marcella (Mike) Brown. Tony was also blessed with 6 nieces and nephews, and 9 Grand Nieces and Nephews. Preceded in death by his parents, Joseph Colosimo and Maria Colosimo-

Voce.
