Anup Singh, age 79, of Powell, OH passed away on May 18, 2019 in Powell, OH. Retired as a Professional Mechanical Engineer and Gas Turbine Specialist at American Electric Power (AEP). Survived by: His Beloved Wife Nirmal K. Singh; His Beloved Daughters Nidhi Huyberechts (married to Didier), Nitasha Singh, and Ritu Singh; His Beloved Grandson Alexander Huyberechts; and Many Beloved Family and Friends. He was a man of many firsts: the first to graduate from college and the first to come to the U.S. in his family. He arrived in the United States 46 years ago on May 21, 1973. In the U.S., he worked as a Professional

Engineer with roles at Sargent & Lundy, Ebasco Services, Parsons, and American Electric Power (AEP) settling with his family in Columbus, OH in 1983. He was an inspiration to many of us and an incredibly kind hearted, loving, and gentle soul. May he be with God and rest in peace.
