Barbara E. Berglund, age 98 of Columbus, died Tuesday September 24, 2024. She was born in New York City, NY to the late William H and Rose C (Brust) Enderley. Barbara had a wonderful life and was a loving wife and mother. During World War II and the Korean Conflict, she volunteered helping servicemen at the USO in New York City. During the 1950's she was secretary to test pilot Scott Crossfield who was the first pilot to fly twice the speed of sound (Mach 2). In the 60's, 70's and 80's, Barbara worked as an executive secretary for a variety of scientific and engineering companies, including North American Rockwell and Perkin-Elmer. She loved skiing and traveling throughout the world, which included numerous cruises. She enjoyed gardening as well as square dancing, round dancing and ballroom dancing. Barbara lived on or near many Strategic Air Command Air Force bases in the US as her husband was an engineer contractor for nuclear missiles. She is predeceased by husband Leonard A. Berglund to whom she was married for 65 years, her daughter Barbara Lynn DePace, her grandson Douglas DePace, her brother Bill Enderley and her sister Nita Bredbenner. She is survived by her son, Leonard A. (Ellen) Berglund Jr., her grandchildren Leonard A. Berglund III, Genny Berglund and John DePace as well as many great grandchildren.
