Barry Galloway Zuk, 69, of Powell, Ohio passed away on Tuesday, August 2, 2022 in Columbus Ohio. He was born on Tuesday, February 10, 1953 to Esther and Alexander Zuk in Newark, New Jersey. He married Leslie Anne Crump on April 26, 1986 in Columbus, Ohio.
