Charles Andreas, Age 88, of Powell, OH passed away Monday, February 16, 2015. Born in Mt. Vernon OH, Charles was a graduate of St. Vincent De Paul School in 1944. A member of the Greatest Generation he served in the U.S. Navy in 1944 and 1945. He returned to Mt. Vernon where he met his future wife Maxine. He earned a B.A. from Kenyon College, Gambier OH in 1949 and was married to Maxine in October of that year. Soon after he began a career with the Columbia Gas System as a Sales Engineer from where he would eventually retire. Charles and Maxine spent two years in Zanesville, OH and then moved to Charleston, WV in 1951. They relocated to Upper Arlington, OH in 1973 and in 2002 to Powell, OH. Charles and his wife were founding members of Village Chapel Presbyterian Church in Charleston. Charles was a devoted father, grandfather, and husband. He was preceded in death by Maxine.
