Charles R. Johnson, Sr., age 93, passed away Friday, December 18, 2015 at the Ohio Veterans Home in Sandusky, Ohio. He was born on May 25, 1922 in Monroe Co., Ohio to Forest and Lula (Reed) Johnson who preceded him in death. Charles married the love of his life, Martha Jean Shaffer and they were married for 65 wonderful years and she survives in Powell. Charles was a graduate of Granville High School, Class of 1940. He was a WWII Veteran, serving in the United States Navy in the Pacific Theater, and a graduate of The Ohio State University Business School. He had an extensive sales career and was a real estate broker, serving on the Columbus Board of Realtors.
