Charles (Chuck) Ziegler, age 89, died peacefully on Monday, November 17, 2008, at Wesley Glen in Columbus, Ohio. Chuck was born May 3, 1919 in Medina, Ohio and graduated from Ohio Wesleyan University. He spent his early years as an officer in the Air Force. During WWII, he met and married his loving wife, Helen A. Ziegler, in Sienna, Italy. Following the war, they settled in Medina, Ohio, where Chuck joined the family business, Ziegler's Department Store, and raised their two sons, Jeff and Mark. Chuck was very active within the community. At one time he was a member of city council, a long standing member of the Old Phoenix National Bank board, and a 32nd degree mason. He had a lifetime hobby as a HAM radio operator communicating with thousands of other HAMs around the world. His call letters were W8RV. Chuck is survived by his wife Helen; children, C. Jeff (Shirley) of Worthington, Ohio and Mark E. of Ann Arbor, Michigan; granddaughters Pamela (Patrick) Riley, Valerie (Brian) Seitz, Julie Ziegler, Alison Ziegler and Catherine Ziegler; great-granddaughter Lana Seitz and great-grandson Charles (Cal) Riley; sister Mary Stewart; nephews Tom Ziegler, Eric Stewart, Brian Stewart, Gary Stewart, and Scott Stewart. He is preceded in death by his parents Harold and Lucile Ziegler and brother, Richard. A celebration of Chuck's life will be held in the Longworth Auditorium at Wesley Glen, 5515 N.
