When she moved to Worthington, she fulfilled a life-long goal by returning to school at Otterbein College to become a registered nurse.

Corinne and John enjoyed an active busy social life with friends and family scattered throughout the United States. They were married for 62 years. Their children were able to surprise them with a party for their 50th wedding anniversary.
