Daniel James Guthrie, 70, of New Albany, Ohio, passed away on Monday, December 9, 2024. He honorably retired as a Sergeant with the City of Columbus Division of Police after faithfully serving 28 years. He held assignments in Narcotics, Patrol, Burglary, Homicide, Crime Scene Search, Freeway, Training Academy (In-Service Training Unit), Internal Affairs, Juvenile (Exploited/Missing Children's Unit) and Accident Investigation.
