David Lowell Bolon, age 92, of Columbus, Ohio was called to be with the Lord on Friday, February 19, 2016. He was born on December 14, 1923, in Girard, Ohio. Dave was a veteran of the United States Navy and served during WWII during which time he received a good conduct medal and victory medal. He was a long time self-employed clock-maker and employee of DeMers Authorized Service in Columbus, Ohio. He was predeceased in death by his parents, Ray and Helen (Herman) Bolon and sister, Ruthe McGhee.

Dave is survived by his loving wife of 68 years, Dorothy A.
