Dawn Elick Hosmer, age 51, of Powell, Ohio passed away July 5, 2022 at The James Cancer Hospital at OSU Wexner Medical Center after a courageous battle with stage IV metastatic breast cancer.

Dawn was born on February 12, 1971 in Lancaster, Ohio as the only child of Joyce Boyer and Dave Elick. She graduated from Lancaster High School and went on to receive a degree in Sociology from Ohio University, after which she worked in the social services field for more than 20 years. In 2004, she was diagnosed with Crohn's Disease, the frequent flare-ups of which limited her ability to work outside the home. After she left her social services career, she then pursued her true passion of writing and became a published author, mainly writing psychological thriller novels. She published five books— “Bits & Pieces”, “Pieces & Parts”, “The End of Echoes”, “Somewhere In Between”, and “Mosaic”.

Her passions in life included a good cup of coffee, reading and writing books, and caring for her family. She was also known to be a compassionate listener — family, friends and strangers alike always appreciated her wise words. She cared deeply for so many people.

Surviving is her husband, Steve Hosmer, and her four children: Krystyna Hosmer of Heath, Ohio; Jesi Hosmer of Westerville, Ohio; Dominic Ritchey

(Sam Henson) of Washington, D.C.; and Gabriel Hosmer of Powell, Ohio. She is also survived by her mother, Joyce (Roger) Boyer of Lancaster, Ohio and her father, Dave (Connie) Elick of Reedsville, Ohio, and many loving aunts, uncles, and cousins.

Services will be held on Saturday, July 9, 2022 at 2 p.m. at the Rutherford Funeral Home, located at 450 W. Olentangy St. in Powell, Ohio. Calling hours will be held from 12 p.m. to 2 p.m. before the service. Caring cremation will take place after the funeral service.
