



## Diane Vogt Siders

October 31, 1934 - April 22, 2023

Diane Vogt Siders, 88 years of age and resident of Columbus, Ohio passed away peacefully at home April 22nd of 2023 after battling cancer, making her the longest-lived member of her family.

She was born to Dana Nevin Vogt and Christine Dennis Vogt in our city on Halloween, October 31st of 1934, and to Nancy Hubbard, her elder sister. Nancy preceded her from this world, as did her son Dean Kevin Siders.

board for Eclipse Theater Company. Her donations to Perkins Observatory were acknowledged

by christening a display room after her sons.
