Donald Blythe Uldricks, a loving husband, father, grandfather and friend passed away at the age of 83 on January 19, 2025 after a determined fight against heart disease. He was born on July 14, 1941 in Kalamazoo, Michigan. Don was an alumnus of Columbus West High School where he was a star athlete in baseball, basketball, and football. He graduated from The Ohio State University in 1963 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration. Don was a proud member of the Phi Delta Theta Fraternity and joined ROTC. He served with the Army in the 101st Airborne Division at Fort Campbell, Kentucky.

During his professional life Don worked at Anchor Hocking, IBM, and was a co-founder of SEA. Don was instrumental in SEA's initial success and growth. Later in life he enjoyed a successful career in residential real estate and became a co-owner of Keller Williams Consultants Realty in Dublin, Ohio.

Don was an instrument-rated pilot and enjoyed flying family and friends back and forth to Florida. He loved boating on Lake Erie and the Gulf of Mexico. He was also an avid tennis player and played with his tennis teams in National Championships. He loved the Ohio State Buckeyes, chocolate, Coke Zero and spending the winters in Naples, Florida. 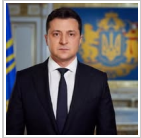
