Donald W. Hindes, age 96, of Columbus, died at his home on Easter Sunday, April 24, 2011. Born in Columbus to the late Earl and Florence Hindes, Don was a graduate of Columbus North High School, Class of 1932. While attending The Ohio State University as a cadet in the ROTC program, Don trained for deployment in WWII and was deployed under the Thompson Act. Don attained the rank of Major in the United States Army and was awarded The Bronze Star medal. He was assigned to the 16th Armored Division in the European African Middle Eastern Theatres. Before his deployment in the Army, Don married Jane Pappa in Watertown, NY. Before the war and immediately after, Don worked at the American Pad and Textile Company, serving as Vice-president, Operations. Later he worked for Ferno-Washington Inc. of Wilmington, Ohio and retired with the company as Vice-president, Sales. Don is survived by his beloved wife of 68 years, Jane P. Hindes, of Columbus; sister Dorothy Hindes Savage, of Westerville; children: Donna Hindes (Jan) Beery, of Pickerington; John Robert (Gloria) Hindes, of Parma Heights; and Meg (Jodie Baker) Hindes, of Washington Court House; 6 grandchildren; 9 great-grandchildren; special niece Joanne Savage Davis, of Columbus; and many other nieces and nephews; and special friends: Frank and Kitty Batchelder, of Columbus and Mary Lou Zoldak and family, of Greenfield, OH.
