Donald George Morgan, age 76, passed peacefully into God's hands on Saturday, January 24, 2015. He grew up in rural North Dakota, and graduated with a Bachelor's degree from North Dakota State University. He joined the Navy and served his country as a Lt Commander on the U. S. S. Yorktown and on the Pacific Island of Chichi-jima. He worked for Electronic Data Systems (EDS) until his retirement after 30 years, working through seven homes in seven states and millions of miles of travel. After retirement, he moved to the beautiful mountains of Colorado Springs, Co, where he and his wife, Lavone, had many enjoyable years, traveling and doing woodwork. Don was a dedicated father and husband. He was known as "Super Dad" to his children and many of their friends, because of his gregarious sense of humor and because he often piled everyone in the car for a trip to Dairy Queen. He loved getting his friends and family together in Las Vegas for long weekends and big steak dinners at Circus Circus. He was a loving and generous grandfather. Even in his slower last few years, he had a knack for bringing humor and joy to the people around him. 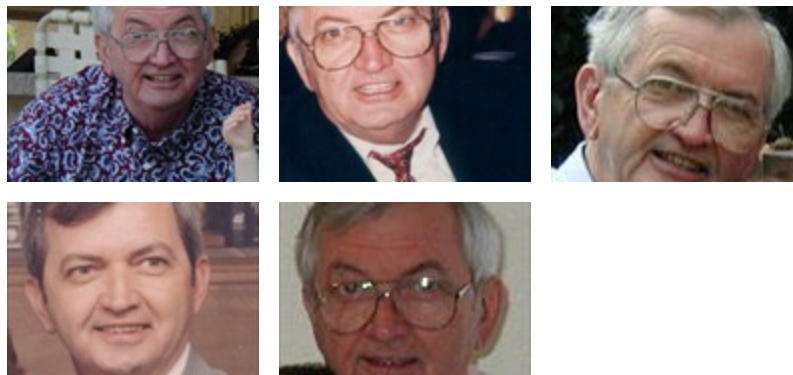
