Dorothy (Dottie) Agnes Bolon, age 91, of Columbus, Ohio was called to be with the Lord on Tuesday, November 7, 2017. She was born on December 28, 1925 in Chillicothe, Ohio, to Clara and Charles Slaughter.

Dorothy's childhood was spent on her family's farm near Chillicothe, Ohio, where she graduated from Huntington High School. She considered herself a farm girl and carried with her throughout her life the values she acquired while living a simple and joyful life on the farm.

After high school, Dorothy moved to Columbus to attend Bliss College. It was during this time that Dorothy met the man who would become her beloved husband, David Bolon, the love of her life.

Prior to her marriage, however, she moved to Crawfordsville, Indiana, where she attended Western Union School to train as a telegraph operator. After graduation she moved to Galion, Ohio, where she solely operated the Western Union office.

Dorothy returned to Columbus a year later. She and David were married on

September 21, 1947, starting a family shortly thereafter. Dorothy's dream of becoming a wife, mother, and a homemaker took flight and fulfilled her throughout the remainder of her life.

Dorothy is predeceased by her beloved husband of 68 years, David Lowell Bolon, mother, Clara (Smart) Slaughter, father, Charles Slaughter, brother, Everett Slaughter, and sister, Ruth (Slaughter) Higgens.

Dorothy is survived by her children; David Alan Bolon, of San Diego, California, Deborah Bolon-Feeney (Jon), of Vail, Colorado, Darla Bolon (Mark James), of Columbus, Ohio, grandchildren, Alexandra Marie Feeney of Arlington, Texas, PFC Andrew Ian Feeney, Velsek, Germany, numerous nieces and nephews, friends, neighbors, caregivers at Worthington Christian Village, and by all who knew her.

Most importantly, Dorothy was a woman of faith and spent her life dedicated to the Lord's work as a devoted member of her church families at Broad Street Christian Church in the early years and later, The Church of the Living Word, both in Columbus, Ohio. She was instrumental in growing both churches, teaching Sunday school, serving on countless committees and teams, and witnessing to all those she met.
