Dorthea C. Burkhardt, age 101, of Columbus, passed away Saturday, August 11, 2012 at Mother Angeline McCrory Manor surrounded by her loving family. After High School she came to Columbus to attend the Lillian Johnson Beauty School where she also worked for a year. Then went back to work in her uncle's drug store in Woodsfield. Dorthea met her future husband Francis Burkhardt at a square dance. They both loved to square dance, and were married January 9, 1933. After they married, they bought a little farm, and then moved to Columbus in 1937. Dorthea worked at Sabino's Drugstore. She was a member of the Holy Name Christian Mothers and Holy Name Catholic Church. In addition to her parents, Dorthea was preceded in death by her loving husband, Francis in 1998; brothers, Abraham and Francis Ackerman; sisters, Delores Thompson, Thelma Weber, Helen Pickens, and Pauline Diamond; grandson, Christopher Haney; great grandsons, Ryan and Jonathan Hansen.
