Edward W. Schultz, age 76, of Dublin, Ohio, passed away Saturday, January 24, 2015. Ed was born in Cleveland, Ohio, January 4, 1939 to Clarence and Marguerite Schultz. He graduated from Euclid High School in 1956 and received a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio. While at Miami he was a Resident Assistant for two years at Collins Hall and a member of Beta Alpha Psi Fraternity. Ed was a CPA and began his accounting/finance career at Arthur Young (NKA Ernst & Young) in the Toledo and Cleveland offices in 1960. During his career he was employed at Klingshirn Builders (Vermillion); Squire, Sanders & Dempsey (Cleveland); Porter, Wright, Morris & Arthur and Vorys, Sater, Seymour & Pease (Columbus). Ed was an active member of Indian Run United Methodist Church in Dublin, Ohio. He served as chairman of the Finance Committee for several years. He volunteered his services as an auditor to several Methodist churches in the Capitol North District of the West Ohio Conference. He was a member of the Board of Directors at Friendship Village of Columbus and served as Treasurer for Citizens for Responsible Zoning and Treasurer for the Cortona at Tartan West Home Owners Association. Ed was preceded in death by his parents and his son Steven. He is survived by his wife of 52 years, Laura; his son, Robert (Marisa); his grandchildren, Robert and Olivia; and his brother, Don (Linda).
