WELSH Edward "Glen" Welsh, age 91 of Worthington and The Villages, FL, passed away Thursday, May 3, 2012. Glen, Lt. Col. (Ret.), was a USAF pilot who served in WWII and the Korean War. He was a Purple Heart recipient and a former POW. Involved in operation "Market Garden", his C-47 was shot down over Holland and he was captured by the Nazi Germans. Hospitalized with injuries, he managed to escape with the help of a Dutch nurse. After serving his country, Glen led a loving and full life devoted to his family and traveled the world with his wife Rene. Preceded in death by his loving wife of 47 years Rene, son Doug, parents Charles and Glenna, brother Chuck, and sisters, Helen and Vanda. Survived by sister Cate Hart; son Mark (Kathy) Welsh; daughters, Sharron (Wayne) Donaldson, Jackie (David) McFarland and Toni (James) Nelson; daughter-in-law Dr. Michele Welsh; 9 grandchildren and 4 great-grandchildren. Family will receive friends from 2-4 pm Sunday, May 6, 2012 at RUTHERFORD-CORBIN FUNERAL HOME, 515 High St., Worthington, OH 43085 where a Memorial Service will be held at 4:00 pm.
