



## Edwin E. Hapanowicz

Edwin E. Hapanowicz, age 87, of Powell, Ohio passed on Sunday, August 12, 2012 at Kobacker House in Columbus, Ohio. Born in Utica, NY to the late Anna and Walter Hapanowicz, Ed received his B.S. degree from Syracuse University. During WWII, he was a 2nd Lt., Bombardier in the United States Army Air Corps, 569th Bomb Squadron, 390th Bomb Group, 8th Air Force, European Theatre. He flew 24 missions plus three mercy missions, plus rescue and recovery missions from concentration camps in Germany to hospitals in France and received the Air Medal and Distinguished Unit Citation. After the war, Ed worked for General Electric and retired in 1986 after 34 years of service. He married Helen Heigle in 1955 and together they raised four children. In addition to his parents, Ed is preceded in death by his brothers Bruce, Walter, Thaddeus and Richard and his sister Irene. He is survived by his wife of 57 years, Helen H. Hapanowicz; four children: Robert E. (Tina) Hapanowicz of Pittsburgh, PA, Karen A. (Ronald) Olson of Orchard Park, NY, Judy Sekinger of Dublin, OH and Joanne M. Mollenhoff of White Bear Lake, MN; his grandchildren: Christina and Bobby C.
