Eleanor Dryden Mogen died peacefully on March 25, 2026, at age 93. Ellie lived a long and full life. She was an expert seamstress, a spectacular knitter, and an avid gardener, in addition to being a supportive sister and wonderful mother. Born in Baltimore, Ellie grew up in Minneapolis and moved to Dublin, Ohio in 1983. One of the first things she and her husband did in Dublin was to find a church; they were one of the first members of St. Patrick's Episcopal Church. St. Pat's became the center of Ellie and Don's life, both spiritually and socially. Over the years, Ellie served on the Altar Guild, the group which prepares the sanctuary for worship and cleans up afterwards; organized, prepared and served weekly meals for the homeless; was a member of the Knitting Guild, making prayer shawls and knitting stuffed animals for sale to benefit the church; as well as contributing on many other committees and projects.

She was predeceased by her parents, Amie and Phil Russell, and her husband of 64 years, Don. Ellie is survived by her three children, Amie Sweeney, Russ (Carol) Mogen, and Phil (Jen) Mogen, and the lights of her life, her eight grandchildren: Maggie and Teddy Sweeney; JD, Connor and Carabell Mogen; and Mimi, Winnie and Charlie Mogen. Also surviving her is her sister, Byrne, and many nieces and nephews.
