Elmer Dwane Prouty (82) passed away on Sunday, August 2, 2020. He was born in Cambridge, OH on Monday, December 27, 1937. Preceding him in death were his parents, Walter & Mary Gladys Prouty; son, Jeffrey Dwane Prouty; siblings Lois Bell (Charles), Ellis Prouty (Mary), and Walter Prouty.
