Eugene (Andy) Anderson, 91, passed away Saturday, December 3, 2022 at Riverside Hospital after complications from 2 falls. He was born July 6, 1931 in Columbus, Ohio to Bill and Marie (Mink) Anderson. Andy's family moved to Powell where he graduated from Powell High School in 1949 in a class of 13. Another member of that class, Rose Evalyn (Plummer) Anderson, caught his eye back in Junior High at the age of 13; she became his forever love and they were married in 1951. That union lasted 60 years until Evalyn passed away in 2011.

Andy's life was full and satisfying. He initially helped in the family store, Plummer's Trading Post in Powell, but went on to become a contract electrician, owning his own business in Delaware, Anderson Electric Service, for decades. Andy was also a dedicated Delaware County Board of Election presiding judge and a Delaware County Fair worker for many years. He was a Mason for over 50 years and proud to have earned that distinction. But by far, Andy was most proud of his involvement with Liberty Township Fire Department. He started as a volunteer just out of high school and finished as Chief after 40 years. He loved to be of service to people.

Andy is survived by his four children: Vicky Cremer of Delaware, Debbie (Joe) McMillan of Delaware, Bill (Denise) Anderson of Delaware, Jim (Lisa) Anderson of Hilliard. He has eight grandchildren: Elizabeth (Cremer) Zemke, Brian McMillan, Mike McMillan, Christopher Anderson, Zachary Anderson, Samantha Anderson, Ben Anderson, and Nicolette Anderson, along with

seven great-grandchildren, and special friend Phyllis Beasley.
