Lale was born in Johnstown, Pennsylvania, graduated from Johnstown High School, and Seton Hill College, Greensburg, PA. Lale was both a mother and teacher to many young people. She began her career teaching at Windber, PA. High School, retiring from Westerville's Walnut Springs Jr. High. She enjoyed spending time with her children, grandchildren, and their many friends. Her door was always open to anyone who stopped at her home.
