An avid walker, she was averaging about 5 miles a day until she was about 85 years old. Fiercely independent, she lived alone in her own home until almost 88 years old. She reluctantly moved to assisted

living, at Abbington in Powell, the last 18 months of her life, and came to love the staff, who treated her like a queen.
