Evelyn Helen Daiber Workman, 86, of Powell, Ohio, passed away peacefully on August 14, 2025. Born in Cleveland, Ohio, December 15, 1938, a daughter to the late Emil Daiber and Elfrieda (Smith) Daiber, Evelyn graduated from Cleveland John Marshall High School with the Class of 1956. She earned her bachelor's degree in speech and hearing therapy from Ohio University.
