Forrest Carter Fuller, 51, of Powell, OH passed away Tuesday night, April 18, 2017.

He was born July 21, 1965 in Toledo, Ohio to George Henry Fuller and Martha Jean (Poling) Fuller.

Forrest graduated from Lima High School and later went on to graduate from Franklin University with a bachelor’s degree in Computer Science. He worked as a computer programmer with Simonton Windows and was a member of St. John’s Episcopal Church.

He tried to help where he could. Forrest was a foster and adoptive parent, Mentored with Big Brothers Big Sisters, contributed and donated blood through the American Red Cross, was an organ and tissue donor, bell ringer, and volunteered to pick trash up along the highway.

Forrest always had a big smile and warm heart, and is very much missed. Left to cherish his memory is his wife of 13 years, Kim Fuller; children, Kaleb and Kai; mother, Martha Jean Fuller; brothers, Mike (Connie) Fuller of Celina, OH, and Matthew (Rachael) Fuller of Baltimore, MD; sisters, Melanie (Tim) Poling,

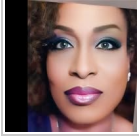

“ *I'm deeply saddened by the loss of Forrest. He was an amazing person, one of the nicest guys I've ever met. We worked together at Simonton for nearly 5 years, and we sat side-by-side for the 4 months before Forrest went on medical leave. I learned so much about Forrest! I learned that he had a huge heart, for his wife and kids, and for the Big Brothers program. I learned that he loved motorcycles but failed his first attempt at getting his motorcycle license (there was a lot of ribbing about that at work!). I learned about his "geeky" love of radios, and how he went to a radio convention every year. He talked about taking the boys when they were older. He loved to run, drank way too many energy drinks (although now that I have 2 kids myself, I understand!), and ate Panda Express more than a human should.
