Frederick C. Williams left this world March 19, 2012 in Beaufort, SC. Fred was born September 24, 1932. As a small boy he was fascinated by airplanes and announced then that he would be a pilot, and he did become a Naval Aviator and a commissioned officer in 1951 following his graduation from Miami University in Oxford, OH., which he attended on a full Navy scholarship. At Miami he was a proud member of the Alpha Chapter of Sigma Chi. He married his college sweetheart Mona in 1956 soon after being awarded his wings. In 1961 following his naval service, they settled in Upper Arlington, OH, where Fred worked as an architect and retired from the firm of Williams Shepherd in Dublin, OH. He was licensed in over a dozen states. After he retired, he and Mona relocated to Beaufort, SC in 2005. Fred was a devoted and much beloved son, husband, father and grandfather.
