Dr. Frederick A. Wood, DVM, passed away on January 28, 2018 at the age of 80. Fred was very community minded over the years both in Marietta & Gahanna, Ohio. Fred graduated from Worthington High School in 1955 where he was class president for 3 years and Student Body President during his senior year. He graduated from The Ohio State University with a BS degree in Agriculture and a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine. He owned and operated Woodside Veterinary Hospital in Marietta for 20 years. Due to health limitations, Fred pursued a career change to public health and Ohio Government Administration. He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Gail, and his son, Matthew and wife, Leslie, of Wadsworth. He was the proud grandfather of Alyssa & Alex Wood; step-grandfather of Jeremy & Jarred Jones and step-great-grandfather of Cora & Charlotte Jaxson & Nevaeh Jones. Preceded in death by his daughter, Cinda Wood Jones in December 2009. Also preceded in death by his parents, Wilber B. & Alice E. Wood; brother, Dr. Phillip Kent Wood & sisters, Anna Knarr & Mary E. Davis; in-laws, Florence & Frank Traver & brother-in-law, Bob Traver. Fred was active in the Ohio Veterinary Licensing Board from 1999-2004 and president of many other boards and groups.
