Geoffrey L. Bush, age 74 died peacefully on Sunday, May 14, 2023. He was a 1966 graduate of West Branch High School in Beloit, Ohio and held a bachelor's degree from Bowling Green University. He also served in the US Navy during the Vietnam War. He was a proud Eagle Scout and loved volunteering with the Boy Scouts for many years. Geoff was a member of the Knights of Columbus at St. Joan of Arc Catholic Church in Powell, Ohio, dedicating many hours to whatever project the Knights were involved in. He married his childhood sweetheart, Leslie Landwert in 2002. Together they started a fundraising business and held sales events for many hospitals and corporations in Ohio and Indiana raising thousands of dollars for numerous charities and projects.
