him great joy watching his girls bake around the holidays, a tradition taught by he and Wilma and carried on through the years. He checked on his girls often and kept up with the grandkids. He was a dreamer. He had great visions of living in the mountains, and again one day having a farm with horses, cows, and chickens. Dave had a deep unwavering faith in God and took pride in instilling morals and values in his children. He was confident in his faith and knew he would one day be reunited with his mother.
