Glenn D. Miller, age 87 of Columbus, died Monday February 10, 2020 at Riverside Hospital. Glenn was born in Shanesville, Ohio on July 17, 1932 to the late Arthur and Ora (Burkey) Miller. He was a member of the Garaway HS Class of '50 and received his BS from Kent State University. After serving in the US Navy during the Korean War, he became an agent for the Allstate Insurance Company. 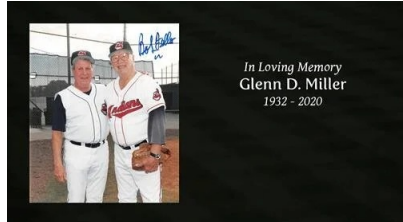
