Graham MacLeod Fee, 88, of Columbus, OH passed away peacefully after a brief illness on Monday, May 5, 2014. Graham was born in 1926 in Duluth, MN to the late Flora (MacLeod) Fee and Graham Bertrand Fee. He spent his younger years growing up in Superior, Wisconsin and as a pre-teen, moved to Whitefish Bay, WI. Following high school, he served in the United States Army, in Italy during WWII as a code translator in a field artillery unit. After the war, he attended the University of Wisconsin, Madison and studied electrical and mechanical engineering. He worked as a Research Engineer for True Temper Corp. located in Geneva, OH, where he also raised his family. During retirement, he lived in Siesta Key, Florida and most recently Columbus, OH. Graham was married for 21 years and was preceded in death by his wife, Luella Mae (Venman) Fee of Geneva, OH, his parents, including Lenna (Page) Fee, of Milwaukee, WI.
