Grant Mason Rhue, a relentless fighter and friend to all, passed away peacefully on October 22nd after a 15 month battle with pancreatic cancer.

Grant was born on April 17th, 1992 to mother Judith and was raised in Athens, Ohio alongside siblings Martha, Alex and Steven. From as early as he could remember, Grant had a dream of becoming a pilot. He went on to attend Ohio University's Russ College of Engineering, excelling in national level flight competitions and becoming a Certified Flight Instructor. After graduating college, Grant flew medical evacuations and corporate aircraft before finding his commercial airline home at Republic Airways as an honorable Captain. Grant's impressive career landed him in Columbus, Ohio where he met his soulmate and wife, Ellie.

Grant lived to help others, loved to share his extensive knowledge of aviation, and took pride in being best dressed. He enjoyed time with family, especially his nephews, and was always up for trying anything once. He lived a life he was immensely proud of even when battling aggressive cancer. Grant will live on through his large aviation family, fitness community, many friends and loving family who hold onto his personal mantra adopted during his cancer battle: "I'm not going anywhere."

“ I was lucky enough to fly with Grant at Republic. He was the kindest person I’ve ever met.

Some of my memories of Grant;

Grant and I had a long Madison WI overnight and walked the city, explored the campus. We ended up having a few beers at the Union over looking Lake Mendota-of course talking all things aviation. He also told me about his family and how he was a triplet, along with growing up in Athens.

Another great memory was in Halifax, Nova Scotia. First flight of the day and after Grant did his pre-flight he showed me a picture of the right main outboard landing gear, where it appeared to be showing metal cord. So I called maintenance and they requested a picture to be sent so they could analyze it as well. Neither of us had data on our phones for Canada. So we decided to go into the terminal to use WiFi. During this time, the cute young gate agent approached us and inquired about a possible delay. After we requested her to hold on boarding till we heard back from maintenance she walked back to the gate area. Grant sends the email with the pic of the tire. And as we are awaiting a response from maintenance, Grant looks at his phone with a quizzical look. So I ask “what’s maintenance saying” Grant “um, she (cute gate agent) just sent me a friend request on Instagram” Grant seemed so perplexed by that, and I just started laughing! We both learned about how many different cords an actual aircraft tire has that day. Nylon and metal?! We agreed with maintenance that we were only seeing nylon and not metal and departed with no delay. But the look on his face about the Instagram request was priceless!

Another fun memory with Grant, we were going into Newark and I was pilot flying. There was a 90 degree cross wind landing runway 4R. Mid twenties on the speed gusting to high thirties. As I was touching down, with cross controls to counter the left crosswind (Grant was pretty new on the jet at the time) Grant yelled “left wing

tip!!!!” and I could tell he wanted to take the controls. I luckily had a super soft landing (no wingtip was harmed) and on the roll out you could audibly hear Grant let out a big sigh. I was laughing so hard! That’s the day I believe earned Grants respect as a fellow aviator.

We all miss you dearly Grant!
