Guy Edward Wilson, age 96, passed away of natural causes Wednesday, February 8, 2012 at Willow Brook Christian Village, Centrum Care in Delaware, Ohio. Guy was born in Waltham, Massachusetts to the late Annie (Perry) and Emerson Wilson on January 20, 1916. He lived most of his life in Massachusetts then resided in New Washington, Ohio from 1993 to 2006. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife of 59 years Ella (Stearns) Wilson and a sister Phyllis Fox. He is survived by one daughter, Carolyn (Robert) Bordner, of Powell, Ohio; two grandchildren: Ben J.
