Haroon A. Aziz, M.D., age 67 of Columbus died Thursday, January 15, 2015 at Riverside Methodist Hospital. Dr. Aziz completed his Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery Residency at The Ohio State University, was in practice for 34 years in Columbus and was the owner of Aesthetic & Plastic Surgery, Inc.
