Herndon P. Harding, M.D., age 78 of Centerburg, Ohio passed away peacefully on Sunday, November 22, 2009 surrounded by his family. He is now with his Savior Jesus Christ in whom he had the assurance of eternal life (1 John 5:13). His family and many friends remember him for his kind and gentle demeanor and in particular his generosity in caring for others both professionally and personally. Herndon was born April 11, 1931 in Worthington, Ohio. He was preceded in death by his parents, George and Mary Virginia Harding. He is survived by his loving wife and best friend Belinda, his children, Herndon P. Harding, Jr., M.D. his wife, Kellie, daughter, Sylvia Kindt and her husband, Gary Kindt, M.D., daughter, Yolanda Londis and her husband, Jeff Londis and five wonderful grandchildren who were the apple of his eye, Austin, Boston, Janzen, Olivia and Savannah. Brothers George, Warren and Richard Harding and sister, Ann Hoxie, also survive him. Herndon lovingly embraced Belinda's family as his own including father Harry, Bev, Doug, Barb, Don, Jerry, Marsha and Nancy. Herndon graduated from Worthington High School in 1948 and Loma Linda Medical School in 1957. He practiced psychiatry at Harding Hospital for 35 years. The family will be receiving friends from 6-9 p.m. Friday, November 27, 2009 at Rutherford-Corbin Funeral Home, 515 High Street, Worthington and 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at church prior to the service.
