Irene Cimoszko, 87, of Dublin and formerly of Ann Arbor, MI passed away peacefully with her family at her side on March 1, 2012 at Dublin Retirement Village. Irene was born in Poland and became a political prisoner/survivor of the Nazi concentration camps, Ravensbruck and Bergen-Belsen. She married Kaz Cimoszko in 1945. They spent 8 years in Vasteras, Sweden then immigrated to the USA in 1953 and became US Citizens. Irene was a devout Catholic who loved music, singing in the church choir for over 40 years, her family, dogs, and gardening. Preceded in death, by her husband, of 63 years, Kaz Cimoszko, she is survived by her daughter and son-in-law Ann and Charles Young and grandsons Michael and Jeffrey Young. She will be sorely missed.
