Jack Roberts Parrish, DDS, of Worthington, died Monday July 27, 2009 at the age of 84. He was born December 14, 1924, in Danville, OH to Gaillard and Beatrice (Roberts) Parrish. He is survived by Mary L. Parrish, his wife of 59 years, and their eight children: Ann (Doug) Fadely of Sunbury; Bea (Daniel) Marshall of Fountain Valley, California; Marti of Springfield, MA; Charles (Stephanie) of Dublin; John (Lien) of Crosslanes, WV; David of Fairborn; Becky (Mike) Telford of Troy; Jennifer (Mike) of Delaware OH. He is preceded in death by his sister Martha Ruth Merrill, of Stuart, FL, and survived by his brother Lanny Parrish of Danville. He was particularly proud of their seventeen grandchildren. He graduated from Danville High School in 1942, served in the US Navy in WWII, graduated from Ohio State University in 1949 and from the OSU College of Dentistry in 1952. He practiced Dentistry in Bexley for 40 years, and taught at the OSU College of Dentistry for 25 years. He also served as President of the Columbus Dental Society, Secretary-Treasurer of the Ohio Dental Association, and impacted the lives of several young men through his participation in Big Brothers. He passed on to his children a love of OSU sports, the Indians, travel, and of course family and friends.
