WOODS Jack L. Woods of Worthington, Ohio, died April 1, 2012. Born Christmas Eve, 1924, he was the founder of Jack L. Woods Plumbing. Jack was a loving and devoted husband and father, a loyal and compassionate friend, a fair and scrupulously honest businessman, a wordmeister, and a witty and charismatic personality.
