“ I am really late for this tribute but I'm going to put it in anyway even if no one sees it. When I was 18 years old and fresh out of high school I worked with Jim for about a year. That was 47 years ago. The name of the workplace was Parttime Temporary Help Services which was located on Spring Street in downtown area of Columbus. When I first walked into the joint, I did not know it was a day labor place. I was hired by Jim not to be a day laborer, but to drive the small bus that would deliver the laborers to various job sites. Basically I, a kid fresh out of a suburban high school, was to transport drunks, hobos, and men who were simply down on their luck, around the city to job sites, then return them to the office at the end of the workday for their pay. It was the greatest learning experience of my life.

Over the years I have wondered what happened to Jim. He probably would not remember me, but I remember him. I'm sad that he is gone, but I'm happy to have once known him, those many years ago.
